When planning your schedule keep in mind that most Vegas clubs don't get really going until around 11pm.

This area transforms quickly though and last week's popular-spot is this weeks outdated news so base your decisions on solid, updated information from those that are truly informed.
- 8) Have every person chip in to a drinks bill to make it easier to pay for drinks when in the clubs and if you are ordering bottle service collect the money from everybody at the time you order.
- 9) If you are planning to have both your wedding and bachelor/bachelorette party in Las Vegas, plan at least a one-day "treatment phase" before the big day. A mammoth hang-over is not going to add to your enjoyment of the biggest day of your life.
- 10) Don't even think about having the bachelor and bachelorette party together or even meeting up at the same nightlife venue. More often than not it leads to unnecessary drama that is better lived without. Trust us; we've seen it all before.
